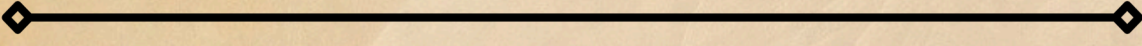

The museum, known by its abbreviation AVAM, was established in 2013 within the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine at Ankara University. Its building, which was opened in 1927, is Turkey's first meteorology building. The design of the structure was prepared by György Tittes, and the construction was executed by Antal Rethly. The meteorology station, which involved Turkish and Bulgarian workers, was transferred to the Faculty of Agriculture in 1933 and later to the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine. After its restoration in 2013, it was transformed into a museum.

In 2023, through our restoration efforts, the period additions on the roof of the building were removed, restoring the roof to its original state. The incorrect plaster applications on the façade were scraped off, and cracks that developed over time were repaired and filled. All wooden joinery was restored and made operational.

Rees Mansion is the building currently used as the Dean's Office of the Faculty of Education in Buca. It was built by the English Rees family in the mid-1800s. Mr. Rees was an official of the Ottoman Railway Company and was responsible for laying the railway line that extended to Buca Station. Rees Mansion reflects the characteristics of typical English architecture. The building has a symmetrical façade, a triangular pediment, and protruding sections, constructed of wood and masonry, with two floors. The ground floor features a spacious hall with a fireplace, leading to a large living room and smaller rooms. The upper floor, accessible by a wooden staircase, also contains rooms. The building, which was used as a mansion by the family for a long time, was confiscated by Governor Rahmi Bey during World War I and began to be used as an official building.

In our restoration efforts conducted in 2023-2024, the period additions around the building were removed without causing damage, and the damaged elements on the roof were renewed to restore the roof to its original state. The cornices and balconies applied on the façade were repaired. The plasters on both the interior and exterior façades were renewed due to water ingress issues. The wooden joinery was restored, and damaged wooden elements in the wooden supporting system were renewed in accordance with the original design, completing the building's restoration.





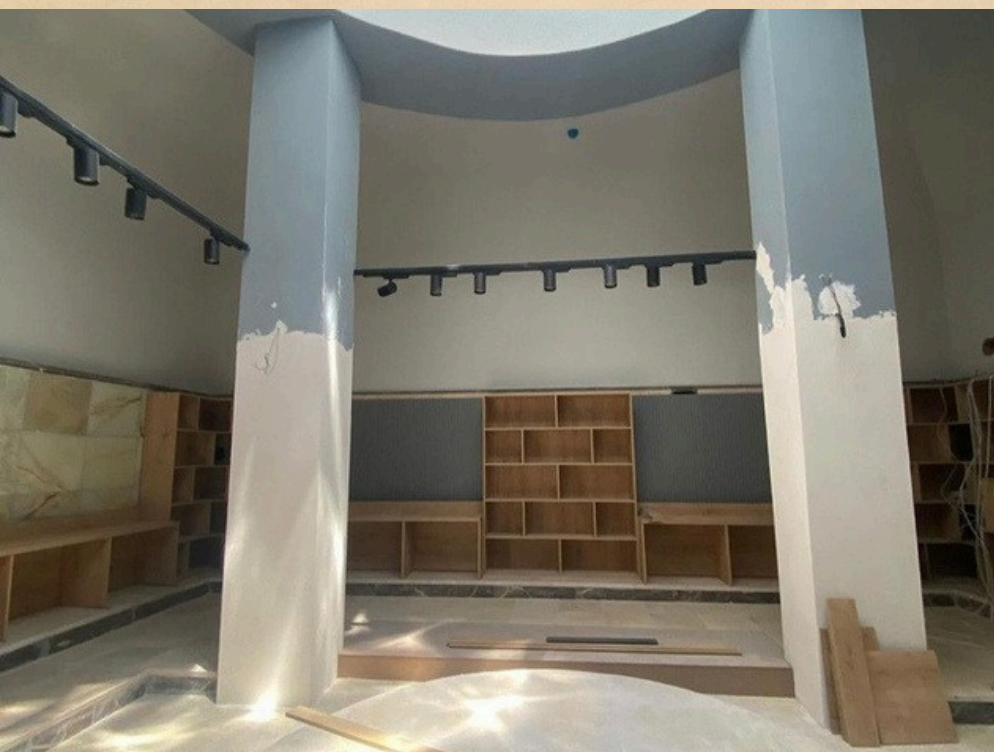

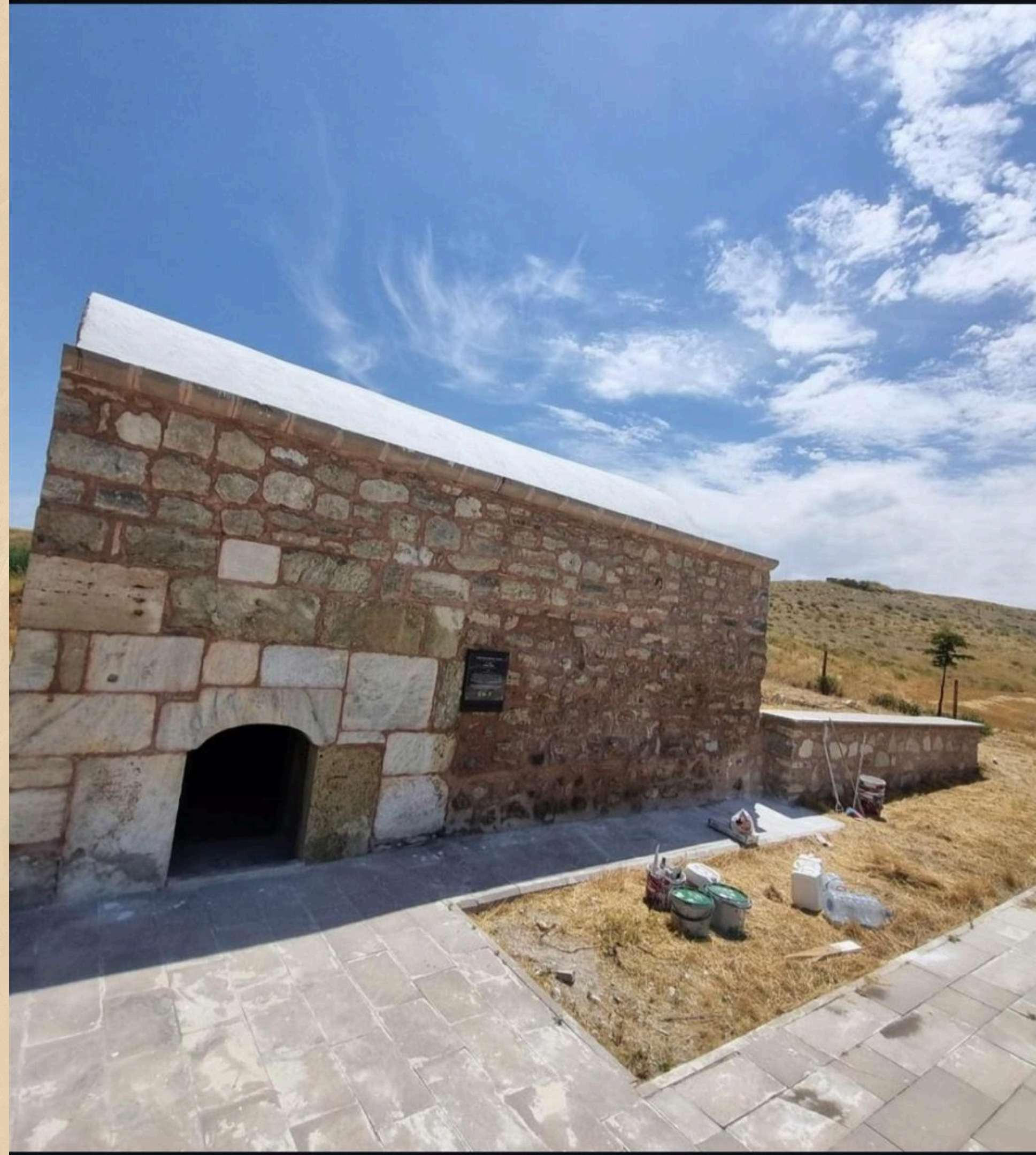
The architect of the bathhouse, constructed in 1937, is Ernst Arnold Egli. The bath building, which we restored in 2024, has been renovated with a modern library café concept, and the damages within the structure have been repaired.





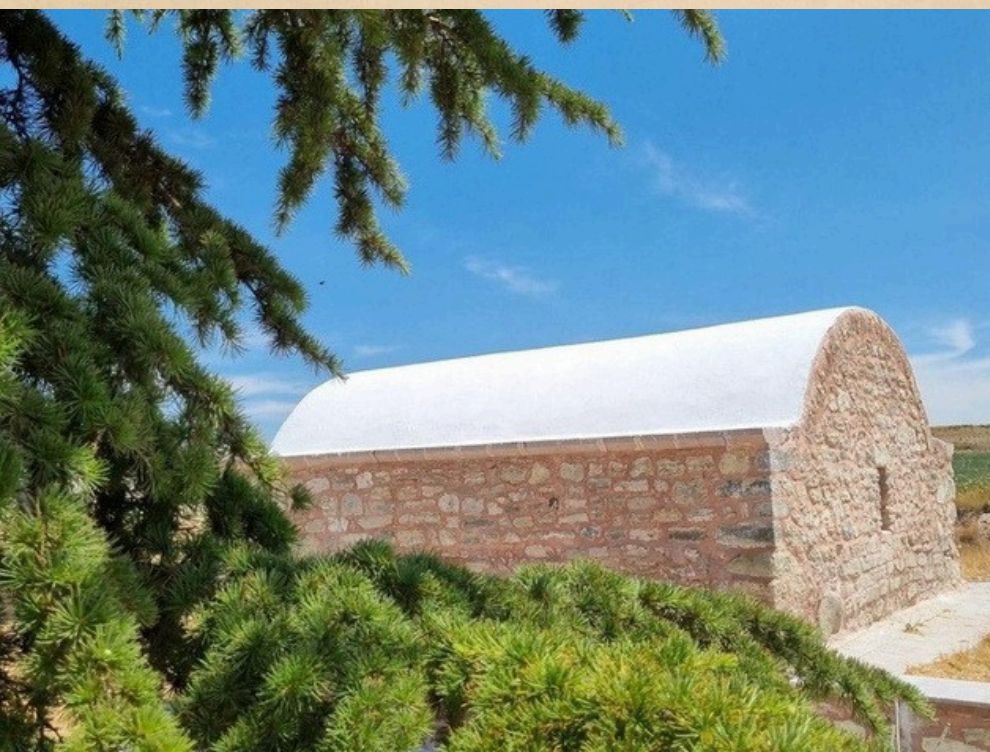

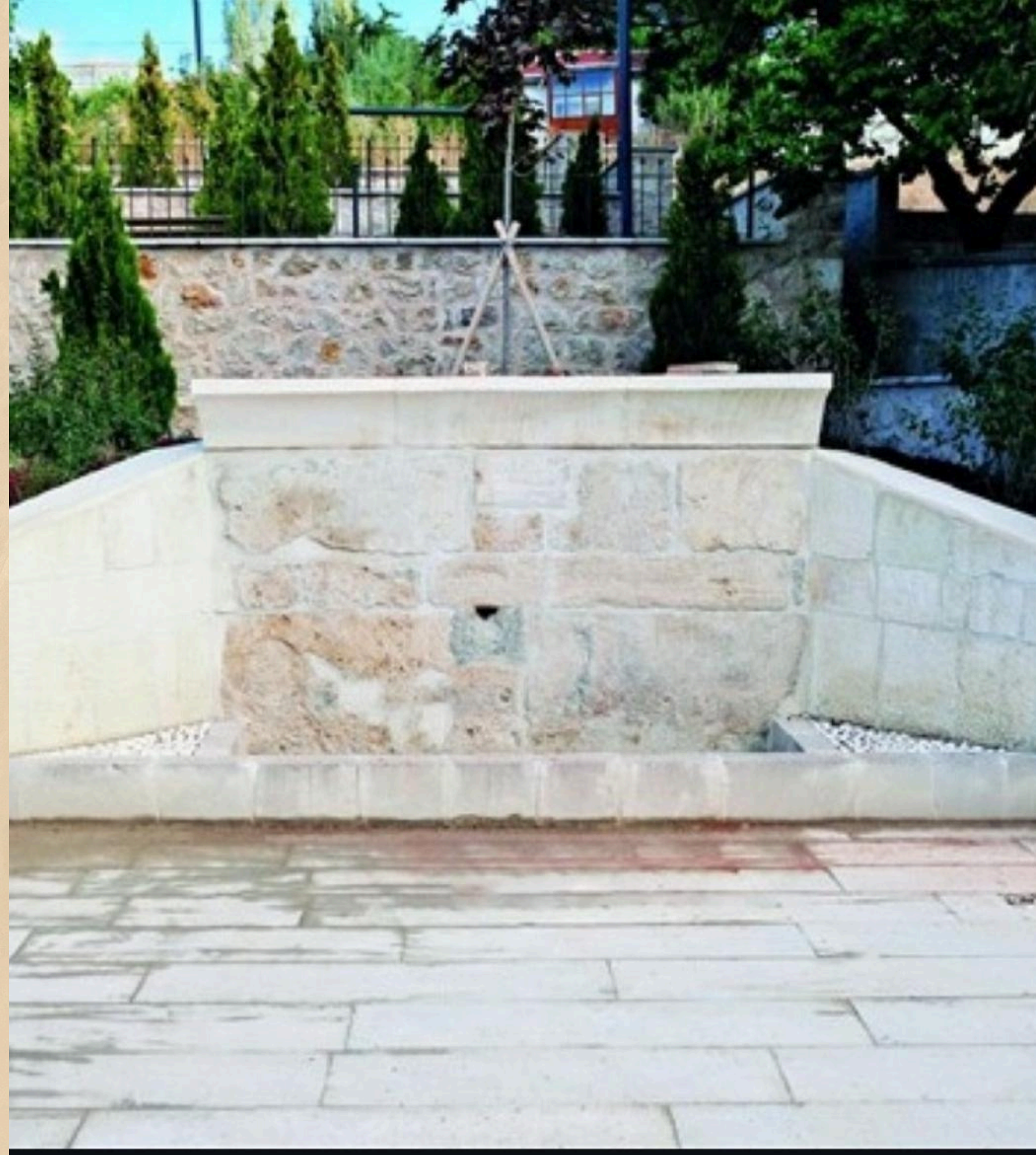




The tomb, located at the foot of a hill about 1 km north of the village, has a longitudinal rectangular shape oriented north-south and is covered with a vault. The northern, southern, and eastern walls of the structure are made of rubble stone, with plaster fragments visible, while the western façade of the tomb, which features a door on the north side, has a more refined craftsmanship, primarily composed of marble and cut stone, including the arched head and surrounds of the entrance. Above the door, there is a small marble inscription slightly displaced to the north of the center. The inscription states that the structure was repaired by Sheikh Mehmed and Sheikh Ali in the year 1249 H. / 1833 A.D. In 2021, the structure was restored in accordance with its essence by removing the concrete vault and additions.

The fountain, located in the town center opposite the market place, was built in 1917 by a family from Kırşehir in memory of Lieutenant Mehmet, who fell as a martyr in the Battle of Gallipoli. The inscription reads: "The benefactor, Kırşehir's first lieutenant Mehmed, who fell in the Gallipoli battle... Year 1335..." The corners and façade of the fountain are made of cut stone, while the water reservoir and trough walls are constructed of rubble stone. The inscription on the fountain is made of marble, and the spout is metal.

The fountain has been completely restored in accordance with its original design, and a park area has been created around it, featuring stone walls that fit the landscape.

It was built in 1592 by a philanthropist named Ahi Ali in the Hepkebirler neighborhood of Kastamonu. Over time, three of the body walls suffered damage and were completely demolished down to their foundations, while one body wall with a mihrab was suspended with wooden supports. The body walls of the structure were restored according to their original design, with oak headers replaced and a sequential masonry system applied. The entire structure was completely restored to its original condition and completed.

Built in 1887, the structure remained in ruins for a long time. Following the restoration carried out by the Kastamonu Provincial Special Administration, which was completed in 2023, it continues to operate as a Vocational Training Center.

Turkmen migrants who moved to Anatolia from various regions settled in different parts of Anatolia, constructing houses that formed the foundation of Turkish residential architecture. These houses share similar characteristics and are significant for the insight they provide into the social life and architecture of their respective eras. These houses are referred to as "Ayaş Houses," and the valley in which they are located also bears the name Ayaş. It is known that the foundations of this neighborhood, which is still inhabited today, date back to the period of 1071. You can see the architecture of historic Turkish houses around the market located in the lower parts of the valley where the Ayaş neighborhood of Ankara is situated. The historical Ayaş houses, which exhibit similar architectural features, carry the typical traces of classical Turkish residential architecture to this day. Generally, they are two stories high and are constructed partially of masonry and half-timber materials.

The structure has been completely demolished and rebuilt in accordance with its original design. The ground floors are constructed with a sequential stone wall masonry system. The wooden ceilings are crafted from special wood materials with unique craftsmanship, reflecting the regional architecture.

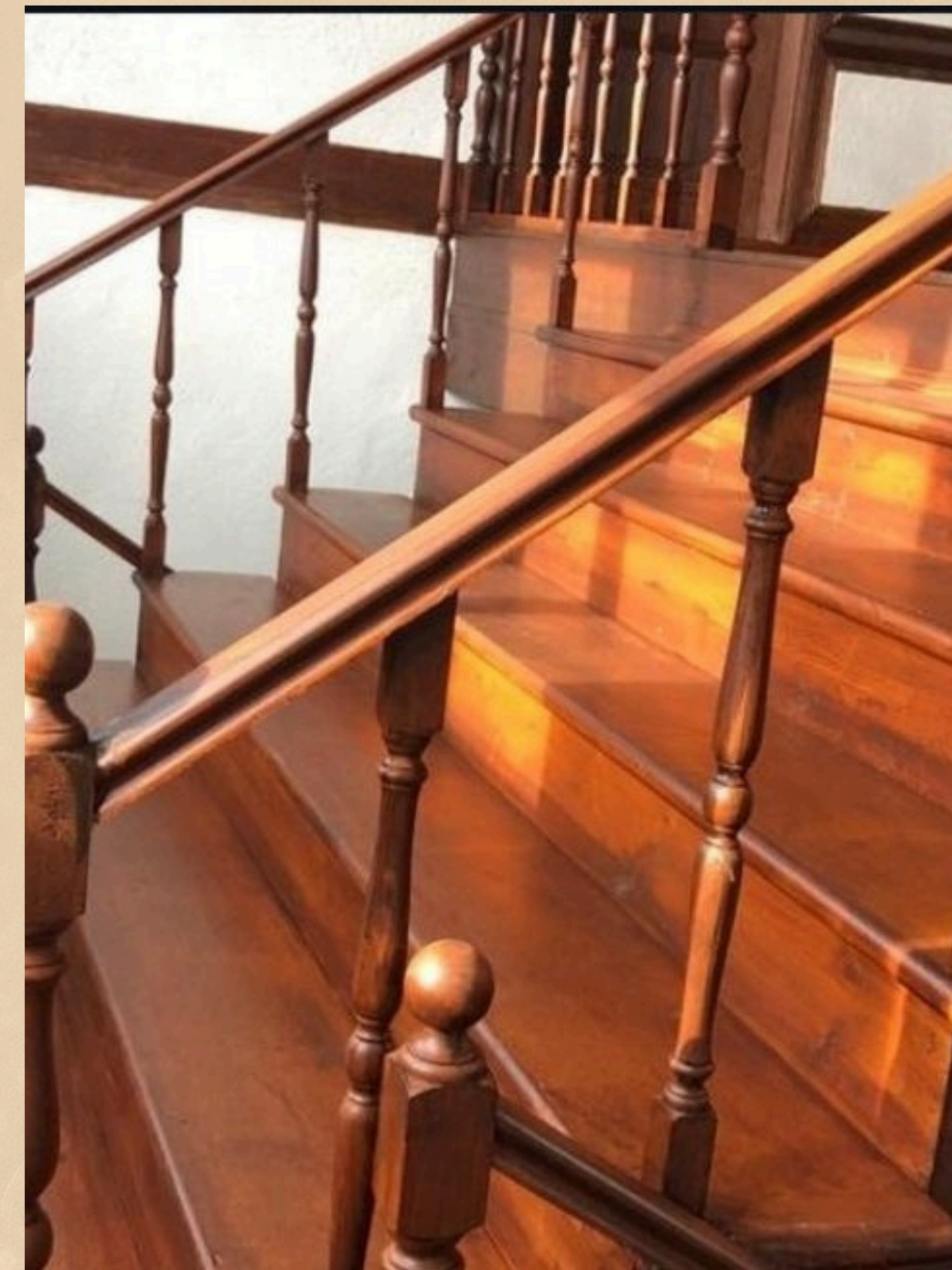
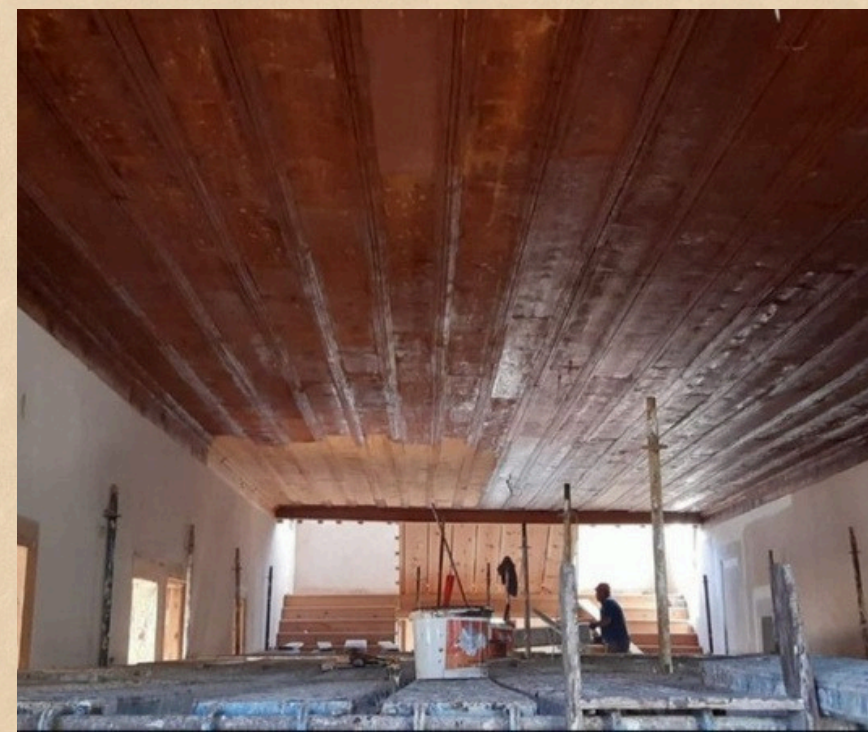

The Daday Government House was founded by Kastamonu Governor Abdurrahman Pasha on August 4, 1891, and its construction was completed in a short period of 3 months and 20 days. In 1893, the walls and ceiling of the office were adorned by the district governor, poet Eşref. Mustafa Kemal Atatürk visited the building on August 30, 1925. The roof, wooden ceilings, wall coverings, and wooden joinery of the structure, which had suffered damage over time, have been restored.

The main service building of the Provincial Directorate of Family and Social Services is a product of the First National Architectural Period, representing a segment of our architectural history. Designed by architect Arif Hikmet Koyuncuoğlu, this building has been recognized as a cultural asset that must be preserved based on the Law on the Protection of Cultural and Natural Assets No. 2863 by the Ministry of Culture until today. The entrance of the main service building of the Directorate, which is located within Ankara's old urban fabric, is situated on Anafartalar Street in the northeast. To the southeast is Acı Çeşme Street, and to the southwest are the Child Protection Institution Office Building and the Child Palace Apartment, both built in 1926. The roof, rain gutters, downspouts, and chimneys of the structure, which had suffered damage over time, have been repaired. Damaged wooden components of the roof structure have been renewed, unnecessary additions have been removed, and the roof has been completely renewed with tile production in accordance with the original design.

In the three-story wooden mansion located in Kurtgömeç Village, Kastamonu, which represents the regional architecture, the damaged wooden elements of the supporting system were renewed through a wooden bracing process. The structure was completely restored in accordance with its original design.

The Arslanhane Mosque, also known as Ali Şerafettin Mosque, is located in the Samanpazarı district of Ulus, in the Altındağ district of Ankara. This structure is situated between Kurnaz Street and Can Street in the Kılıçaslan neighborhood. The mosque was commissioned as a charitable work by Ahi Hüsameddin and his brother Ahi Hasaneddin from the Ankara Ahi community. It was expanded and repaired in 1290 by Ahi Hüsameddin's son, Ahi Şerafettin, by the wood master Dülger Ebubekir oğlu Mehmet. One of the most notable features of the mosque is the use of spolia from the Roman and Byzantine periods. While the mosque has a simple exterior appearance, its interior is elegantly decorated. The fountain has been restored in accordance with its original design and freed from later additions.

It is located on the southeast side of Molla Büyük Mosque. It was built in 1804 by Sahire Hanım. It has a small and square plan and is made of Ankara stone. There are two round columns with fluted tops and Ionic capitals on either side. The middle section is adorned with relief motifs of kenger leaves. The inscription written in thuluth script states: "Masha Allahü Teala / The benefactor, daughter of Tahsildarzade / Sahire Hanım binti Ahmed Efendi, may she rest in peace, 1219."

The fountain, which is located in the Altındağ district of Ankara, is one of the oldest structures in the region and has been restored to its original condition.

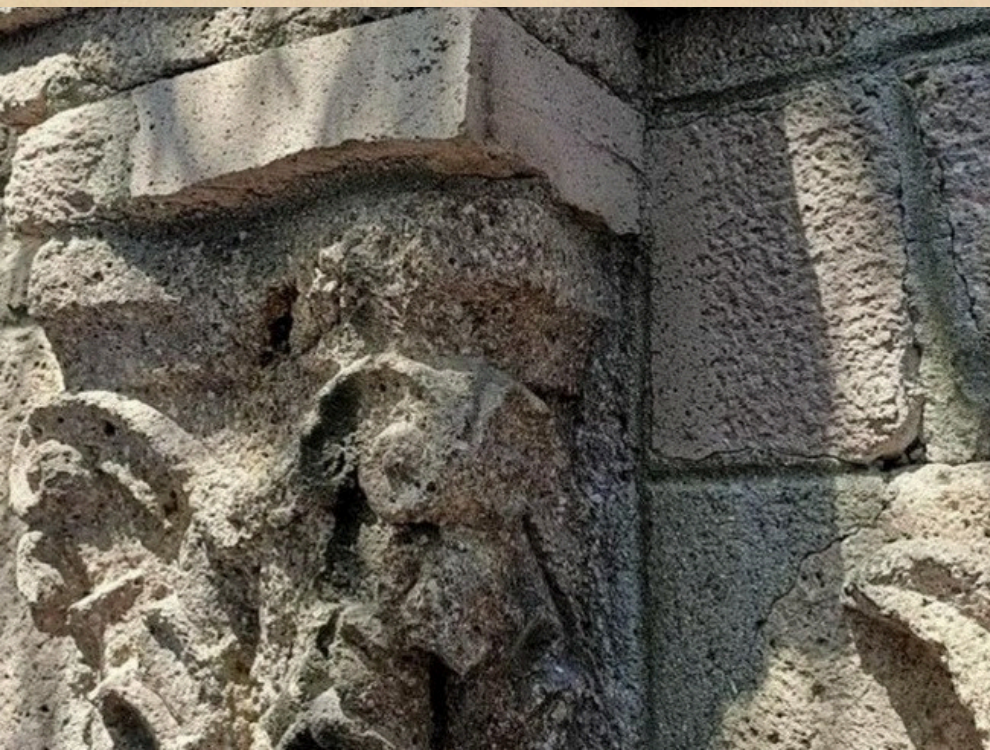

The Gecikkadın Mosque Fountain, according to its inscription dated 847 (1443-44), was commissioned by a person named Hacı İsmâil b. İbrâhim. The structure, which has largely lost its original form, was used as a storage facility by Kızılay for a long time before being restored by the General Directorate of Foundations in 1963 and reopened for worship. The fountain, located in the Altındağ district of Ankara, is one of the oldest structures in the region and has been restored to its original state.

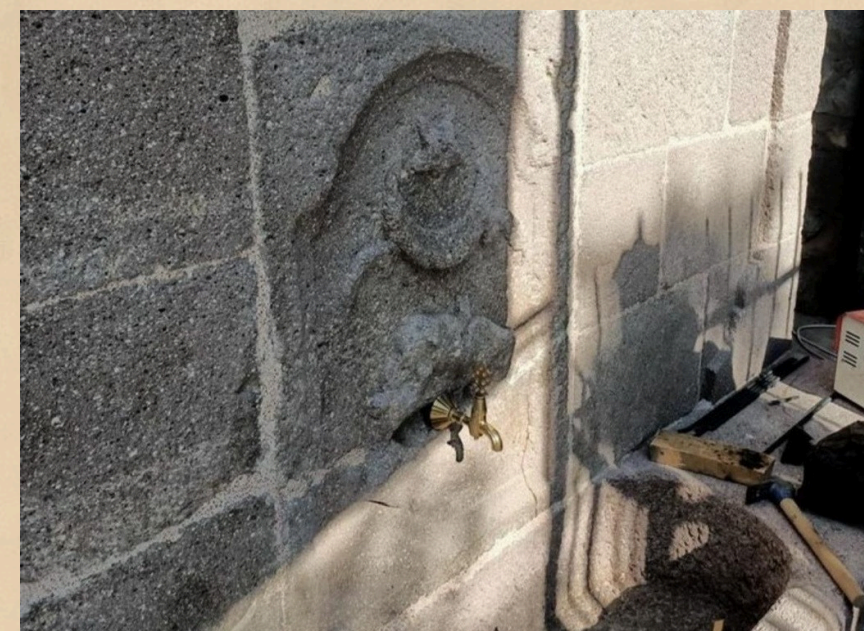
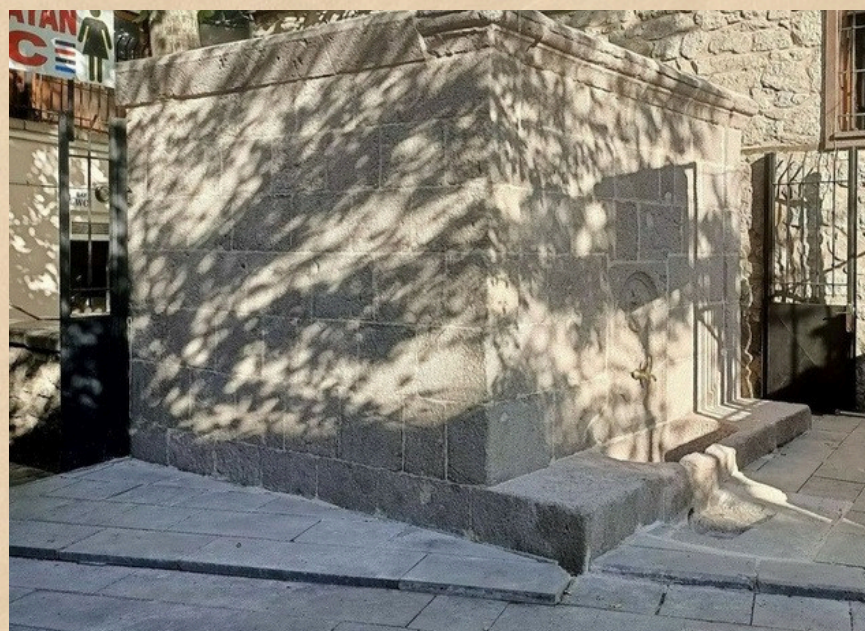
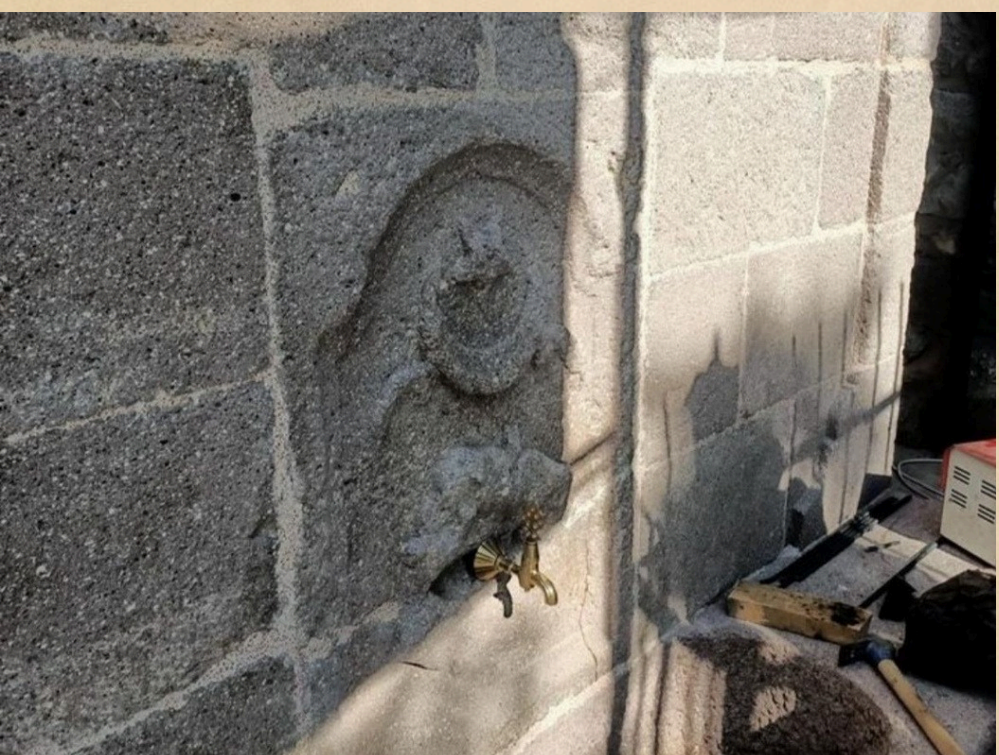

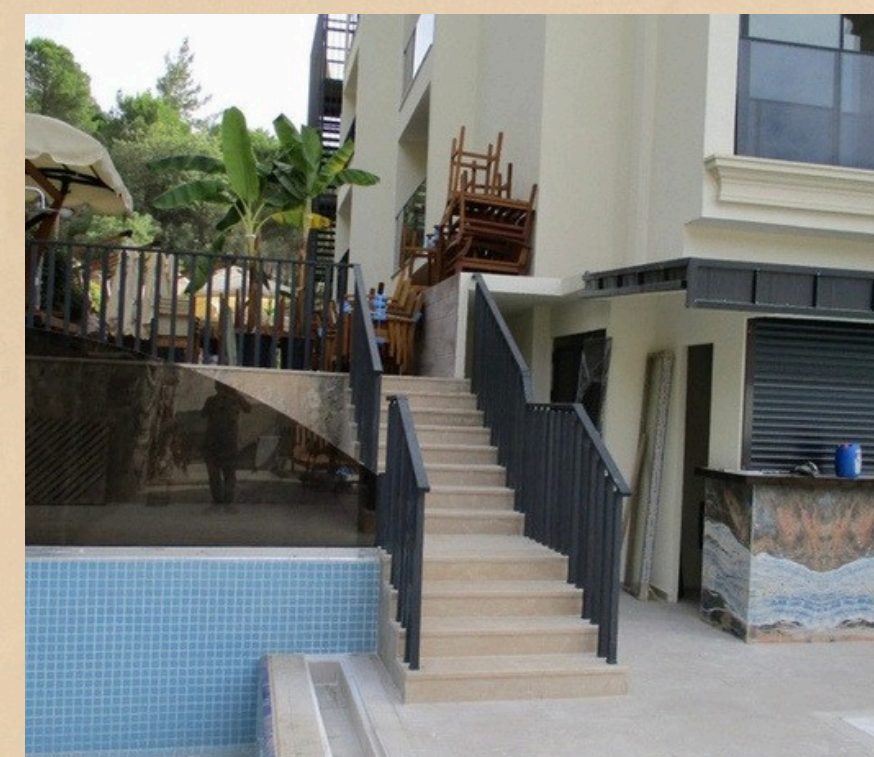


Kağnıcıoğlu Mosque, located on Denizciler Street, is a simple rectangular building that was originally constructed as a masjid. It is also referred to as Ganiğa Mosque. The absence of an inscription suggests that it was transformed from a masjid into a mosque by Mermerzade Ahi İbrahim Ağa, as understood from the foundation document dated 1747-48. A lecture hall and a twelve-cell madrasa (Mermerzade/Ağa madrasa) were also built beside it. According to the foundation document dated 1870, Seyyid Abdurrahman Efendi's wife, Azime Hanım, renovated the mosque and built a madrasa adjacent to it. The General Directorate of Foundations later constructed a house on the site of this madrasa. The minaret was added in 1965. The fountain, located in the Altındağ district of Ankara, one of the oldest structures in the region, has been restored in accordance with its original state.

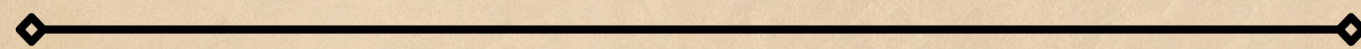

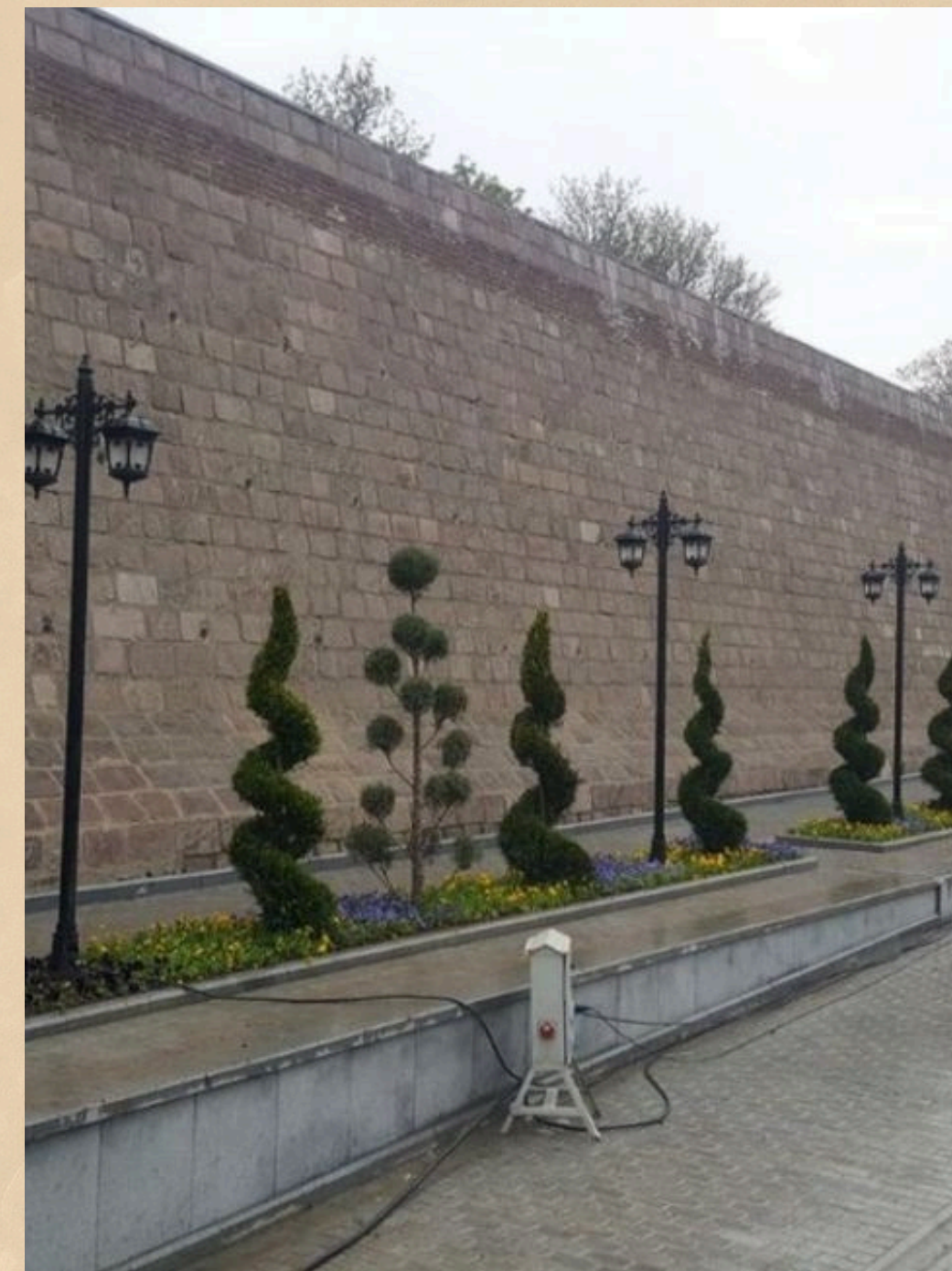




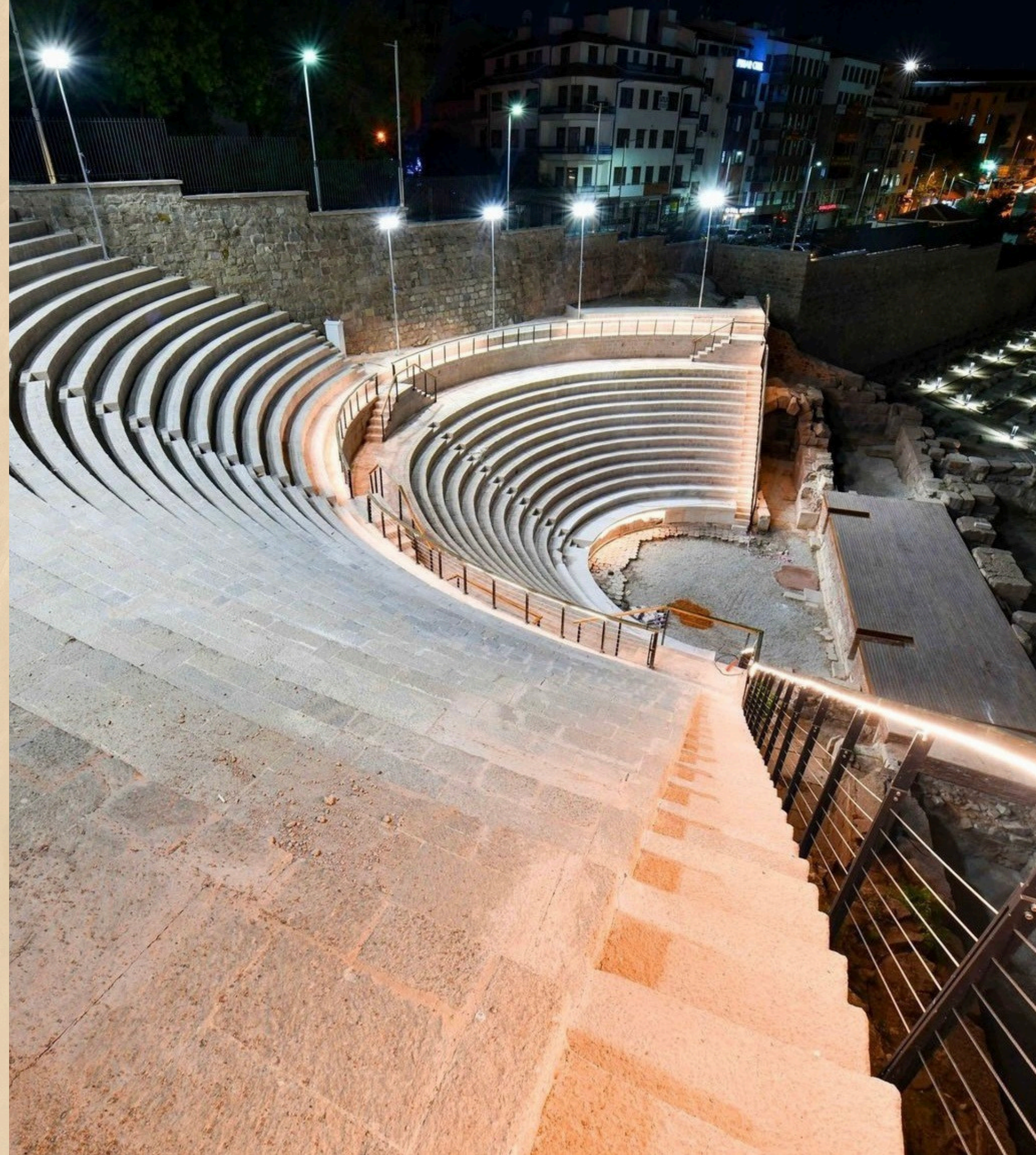
Hacı Bayram Mosque is a historic mosque located in the Ulus district of Altındağ, Ankara. It is adjacent to the Temple of Augustus. The mosque was originally built as a zaviye in the Islamic year 831 (1427-1428), and there is no information available about its first architect, Mimar Mehmet Bey. The current architectural structure reflects the characteristics of 17th and 18th-century mosques. The mosque has a longitudinal rectangular plan, with a stone base, brick walls, and a tiled roof. It is richly adorned with wooden decorations and tile decorations. The wooden elements inside the mosque feature painted motifs attributed to Nakkaş Mustafa Paşa.

On the southeast wall of the mosque, there is a two-balconied minaret. This minaret has a square stone base and a cylindrical brick shaft. It was repaired in 1714 by Mehmet Baba, a descendant of Hacı Bayram Veli. The surrounding area of the mosque and the reinforcement of the collapsed city wall were completed in 2018.

A restaurant, ten shops, a park, and a waterfall have been constructed in a manner suitable for the regional architecture. The demolished historic city wall has been rebuilt in accordance with its original design, and a total of 950 m³ of stone wall construction has been completed. Additionally, 5000 m² of İzmir Bergama tambour granite paving, 3000 m² of andesite wall cladding, and 10 tons of wrought iron railing have been manufactured.



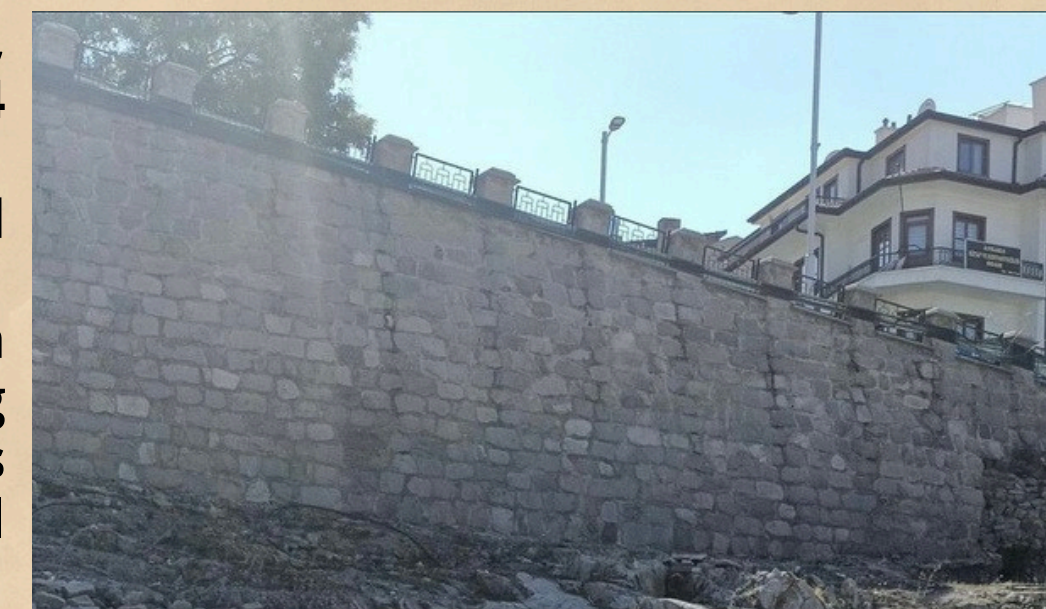

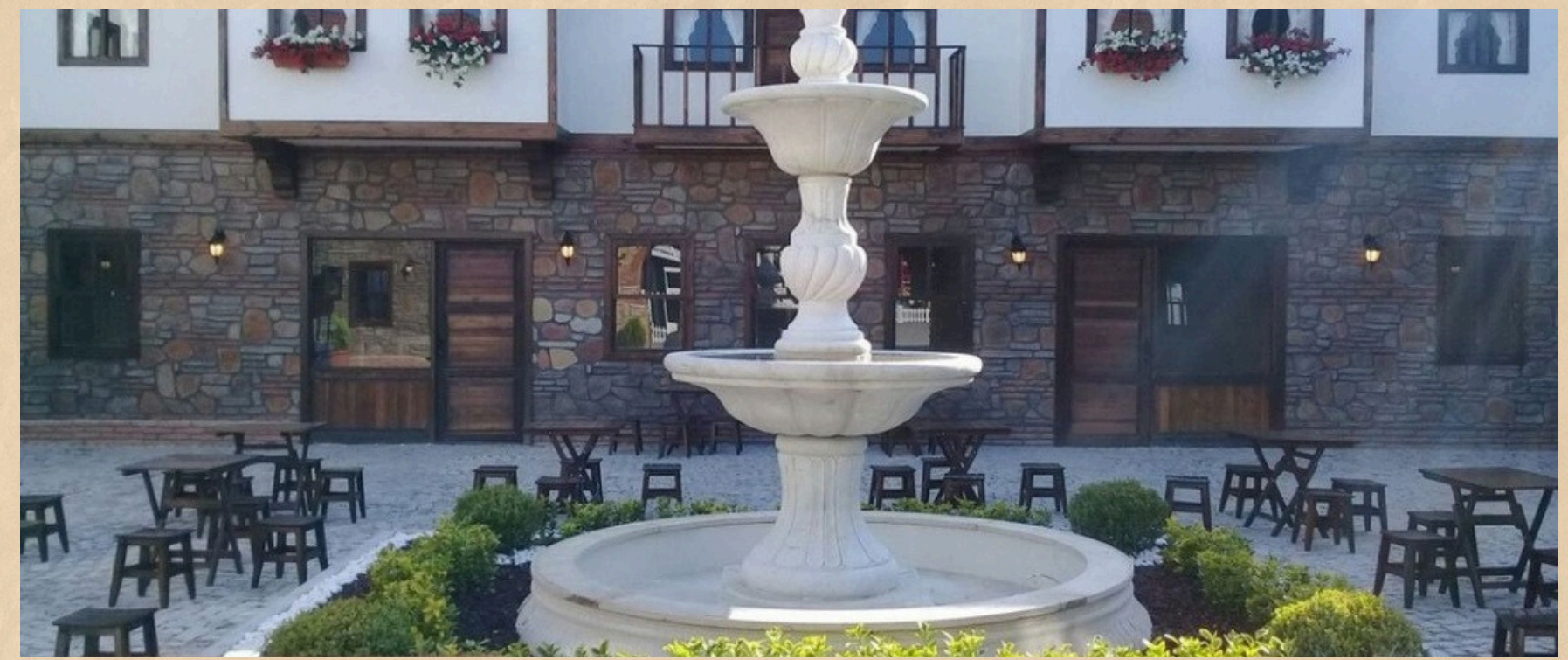
The Roman theatre, belonging to the ancient Ankyra, was most likely built in the 1st century AD for the Actian victory games, which were held every four years following Augustus's (27 BC - 14 AD) victory over Marcus Antonius and Cleopatra at Actium in 31 BC. Site management and consultancy services were provided during the project.

The underground seating rows of the theatre have been unearthed, and the entire structure has been restored according to the approved restoration project, featuring a total of 110 seats in the cavea, constructed using marble and andesite stones, all crafted by hand.

In 2018, the Bedesten Bazaar, representing the regional architecture, was constructed in the Atatürk Cultural Center area of Altındağ, Ankara. The bazaar was built in a remarkably short period of 30 days, adhering closely to its original examples. After the fair and exhibition concluded, the structure was removed.
